



CCTV CAMERA PROJECT

The CCTV camera project is progressing – Thanks for all contributions thus far. Every rand is appreciated and supports our security effort. As indicated in the graph below we have presently received 32% of budgeted contributions (the R150,00 per household) and 38% for the CCTV camera system. We have thus almost reached the target of R25 000,00 for the first camera.

GKTV-KAMERAPROJEK

## OULANDSLOOP'S CONTAINMENT PROJECT

The budget for the serious erosion caused by flash floods in the park is finally approved. It mainly includes making the flood channel shallower and wider and lining the bottom and sides with concrete blocks through which plants can grow. The project also includes a new bridge across the stream, a palisade around the park keeping the current entrances and the upgrading of the paths in the park. Funds were also granted to repair any disruptions caused by the construction.

The most suitable building site for the project was chosen next to the fence in Frank Road. The site is fenced in, has ablution facilities and is serviced by security guards.

The project was handed to the contractor on 18/06/12 and should take about eight months to complete.

The DWRA management committee appointed me as the community liaison officer (CLO). We are very relieved that the project will now start because the level of erosion is dangerous, unsightly and becomes deeper every day. Thank you to everyone at the municipality that was involved in the planning and piloting of the project.

## OULANDSLOOP SE STORMWATERPROJEK

Die munisipaliteit het uiteindelik die geld goedgekeur om die ernstige erosie te bekamp wat deur stormwater in die park aangerig word. Dit behels hoofsaaklik die vlakker en wyer maak van die vloedkanaal en die uitvoer van die bodem en kante met betonblokke waardeur plante kan groei. Die projek sluit ook in die oprigting van 'n nuwe bruggie oor die stroom, 'n palissade rondom die park met behoud van die bestaande ingange asook die opgradering van die voetpadjies in die park. Daar is ook fondse bewillig vir die herstel van enige versteurings wat gedurende die konstruksie in die park mag ontstaan.

Daar is besluit dat die geskikste bouterrein vir die projek direk langs die draad by Frankweg is. Die terrein is omhein, het ablusiegeriewe en word deur veiligheidswagte beman.

Die projek is op 18/06/12 aan die kontrakteur oorhandig en sal ongeveer agt maande duur om te voltooi.

Ek is deur die DWRA-bestuurskomitee gevra om amptelik as die gemeenskapskakelbeampte ('CLO') op te tree. As daar dus enige inwoners is met inligting/kommentaar/wenke rakende die projek, kan hulle my met vrymoedigheid skakel by 0836252329 of 0128075059 of per e-pos kontak by terasmus@telkom.co.za. Ek sal ook die gemeenskap deur middel van ons nuusbriewe gereeld oor vordering van die projek inlig. Ons is baie verlig dat die projek nou gaan begin want die bestaande erosiesloot is reeds gevaarlik, onooglik en dit word al hoe dieper. Ons wil dus graag ons dank oordra aan almal van die munisipaliteit wat betrokke was by die beplanning en loodsing van die projek.
